1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2505, first ¶, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 324, §1, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7	Except as otherwise provided by the municipality's ordinances or charter, an <u>An</u> elected official of a municipality may be recalled from office pursuant to this section <u>or pursuant to a provision of the municipality's ordinances or charter</u> . For purposes of this section, "official" has the same meaning as <u>in</u> section 2604, subsection 2.
8	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §2505, sub-§9, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 324, §1, is repealed.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12 13	This bill allows a municipality to use the statutory procedure or a provision of the municipality's ordinances or charter for recalling an elected official from office and removes the provision requiring that an elected official may only be recalled if the official is convicted of a crime.
