An Act To Exempt Permanently Disabled Veterans from Payment of Property Tax

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §653, sub-§1, ¶D-4 is enacted to read:
3	D-4. For property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2020, the estates, having a
4	taxable situs in the place of residence, of a veteran who provides to the assessor of the
5	place in which the veteran resides certification from the United States Department of
6	Veterans Affairs or any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States that the
7	veteran is permanently disabled and receives benefits based on a rating of 100% for a
8	service-connected disability.
9	The exemption provided in this paragraph also applies to property held in a revocable
10	living trust for the benefit of the veteran.
11	SUMMARY
12	This bill provides a complete property tax exemption in the municipality of residence
13	for a veteran receiving benefits based on a rating of 100% for a service-connected
14	disability.
