An Act To Amend the Laws Governing the Address Confidentiality Program

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §90-B, sub-§1, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 2001, c. 539, §1, is amended to read:
- A. "Address" means a residential street, school or work address of an individual, <u>including any</u> geographically specific description or coordinate that identifies a residential address, as specified on the individual's application to be a program participant under this ehaptersection.
- **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §90-B, sub-§7,** as enacted by PL 2001, c. 539, §1, is amended to read:
- **7. Confidentiality.** The program participant's application and, supporting materials and the <u>program's state e#mail account</u> are not a public record and must be kept confidential by the secretary.
