### An Act Regarding the Placement of Temporary Signs

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶L**, as amended by PL 2019, c. 594, §1, is  
3 further amended to read:

4 L. Temporary signs placed within the public right-of-way for a maximum of 12 weeks  
5 per calendar year, except that a temporary sign may not be placed within the public  
6 right-of-way for more than 6 weeks from January 1st to June 30th or for more than 6  
7 weeks from July 1st to December 31st. Temporary signs placed within the public right-  
8 of-way for a maximum of 30 days from January 1st to June 30th and for a maximum  
9 of 30 days from July 1st to December 31st. A temporary sign may not be placed within  
10 30 feet of another temporary sign bearing the same or substantially the same message.  
11 A temporary sign may not exceed 4 feet by 8 feet in size. A sign under this paragraph  
12 must include or be marked with the name and address of the individual, entity or  
13 organization that placed the sign within the public right-of-way and the date the sign  
14 was erected within the public right-of-way.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill provides that temporary road signs may be placed within the public right-of-  
17 way for a maximum of 30 days from January 1st to June 30th and for a maximum of 30  
18 days from July 1st to December 31st.
