## **SUMMARY**

9 This amendment clarifies that the Department of Health and Human Services is required to examine opportunities to provide home and community-based services to 10 individuals experiencing homelessness using a state plan amendment option under 11 Section 1915(i) of the federal Social Security Act or any other Medicaid-funded 12 mechanism that may be appropriate. It requires the department to report its progress in 13 examining options and submitting a waiver to the Joint Standing Committee on Health 14 and Human Services. The amendment also corrects the appropriations and allocations 15 section to reflect funding from the Temporary Housing Assistance Fund and changes the 16 initiative language to be more consistent with the statute governing the fund. 17
