1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6006 is enacted to read:
3	§6006. Use of student's contact information
4 5 6 7 8 9	Contact information of a student or a parent or guardian of a student that has been provided to a school or school administrative unit in connection with the student's enrollment at the school is part of the student's education record. A school administrative unit or school or a representative of a school administrative unit or school may not use contact information of a student or a parent or guardian of the student to advance any campaign, as defined in Title 21-A, section 1052, subsection 1.
10	SUMMARY
11	This bill prohibits a school administrative unit or school or a representative of a
12	school administrative unit or school from using contact information of a student or
13	student's parent or guardian to advance any campaign as defined in the Maine Revised
14	Statutes, Title 21-A, section 1052, subsection 1. The bill also makes that contact
15	information part of the student's education record.
