Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §701, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2007, c. 663, §2, is further
 amended to read:

4 **3.** Public hearing. The county commissioners shall hold a public hearing in the county 5 on these estimates before the end of the county's fiscal year. They shall publish a notice of 6 the hearing at least 10 days before the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the county. Written notice and a copy of the estimates must be sent by electronic or regular 7 8 mail or delivered in person to the clerk of each municipality in the county at least 10 days 9 before the hearing, and the clerk shall provide confirmation of receipt by electronic or regular mail. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officers of the receipt of the 10 estimates. 11

12 Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §764, as amended by PL 2007, c. 663, §8, is further amended 13 to read:

## 14 §764. Public hearing

The Hancock County commissioners shall hold a public hearing on the budget estimate at least 90 days before the end of the county's fiscal year and an informational meeting on the advisory committee's budget estimates at least 30 days before the end of the county's fiscal year. Pursuant to the requirements of section 701, subsection 3, written notice and a copy of the estimates must be sent by <u>electronic or regular</u> mail or delivered in person to each member of the county legislative delegation at least 10 days before the informational meeting on the annual budget.

Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §855, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and
Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further
amended to read:

25 **3.** Public hearing. The budget committee shall hold a public hearing in the county on 26 the proposed budget before the end of the county's fiscal year and before the final adoption 27 of the budget. Notice of the hearing shall must be given at least 10 days before the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the county. Written notice and a copy of the 28 29 proposed budget shall must be sent by registered electronic or certified regular mail, with return receipt requested confirmation of receipt sent by electronic or regular mail, or be 30 31 delivered in person, with proof received of the delivery, to the clerk of each municipality 32 in the county. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officers of the proposed 33 budget.

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## SUMMARY

35 Current law requires that annual estimates of proposed county taxes and notices of 36 public hearings on proposed county taxes must be sent to the clerk of each municipality in 37 the county by mail or delivered in person and that proposed county budgets and notices of public hearings on proposed county budgets must be sent to the clerk of each municipality 38 39 in the county by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, or delivered in person. 40 This bill allows those proposed county taxes and budgets and public hearing notices to be 41 sent by electronic or regular mail, with confirmation of receipt by electronic or regular 42 mail, or delivered in person.
