1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6552, sub-§2, ¶D is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7	D. The prohibition on possession of a firearm does not apply to a person to whom a valid permit to carry a concealed handgun has been issued by an issuing authority in the State as provided in Title 25, chapter 252 and in accordance with federal law. The person must have in that person's possession the permit as required in Title 25, section 2003.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill allows a person with a permit to carry concealed handguns to possess a firearm on public school property or the property of an approved private school.
