Resolve, to Establish a Pilot Program to Provide Grants to Expand Age Eligibility for Life Skills and Vocational Programs in Public Schools

- Sec. 1. Commissioner of Education to establish pilot program to provide grants to expand age eligibility for life skills and vocational programs. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Education shall establish a pilot program to award grants to expand age eligibility for life skills and vocational programs in public schools for a period of 2 years. The Commissioner of Education may accept donations from outside sources and state and federal funding to accomplish the purposes of this resolve.
- **Sec. 2. Application. Resolved:** That a local education agency may submit an application for grant funds under the pilot program pursuant to section 1. The Commissioner of Education shall give priority to applicants that do not have career and technical education in middle schools and provide grants to schools that demonstrate the following goals:
- 1. Exposing students to vocations so that students can identify a vocational interest earlier in the students' academic careers;
 - 2. Providing students with valuable life skills; and

- 3. Lowering the truancy rate and number of disciplinary infractions by increasing student engagement.
- **Sec. 3. Use of funds. Resolved:** That a local education agency that receives a grant award during the pilot program under section 1 may use the funds only for expanding age eligibility for life skills and vocational programs.
- **Sec. 4. Evaluation; annual submissions. Resolved:** That each local education agency that receives a grant under the pilot program under section 1 shall engage in evaluation activities, including interviews or surveys on the process and effect and outcomes of the pilot program, and annually for the duration of the grant submit to the Department of Education a report or other product that showcases learning achieved through the pilot program. The Department of Education annually shall compile the submissions and make them publicly available.
- **Sec. 5. Fund established. Resolved:** That the Life Skills and Vocational Program Grant Pilot Program Fund is established as a nonlapsing fund under the Department of Education for the purpose of receiving money from state, federal and other sources, including donations from private citizens, corporations and entities for the purposes of this resolve. The department shall distribute any available money in the fund to support the purposes described in this resolve. Upon distribution of all the money, the fund is dissolved.
- **Sec. 6. Report to Legislature. Resolved:** That, no later than December 4, 2024, the Commissioner of Education shall submit a report regarding the pilot program pursuant to this resolve and make recommendations, including any suggested legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs. The joint standing committee may report out legislation on the subject matter of the report to the First Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature.
- **Sec. 7. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
