4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to amend the laws governing stalking and domestic violence by
6	strengthening provisions relating to serial stalking and increasing penalties for defendants
7	with multiple convictions for stalking and domestic violence offenses to better ensure the
8	safety of victims of stalking and domestic violence.
