1 Sec. 1. Secretary of State to review uniform legislation. Resolved: That the 2 Secretary of State shall review the uniform law entitled "Revised Uniform Law on 3 Notarial Acts," which was approved and recommended for enactment by the National 4 Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws on November 15, 2010. In 5 conducting this review, the Secretary of State may consult with state and national associations for notaries public, as well as other experts in the field of notarial law and 6 7 practice. Based on that review, the Secretary of State shall submit a report including a 8 recommendation regarding whether the Legislature should adopt the uniform law, with or 9 without changes, together with any proposed implementing legislation, to the joint 10 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters no later than January 15, 2019. Following receipt and review of the report, the joint standing 11 12 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters is authorized to 13 report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 129th Legislature.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Secretary of State to review uniform legislation governing notarial practice and to submit a report including a recommendation regarding adoption of the uniform law, along with any proposed implementing legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters, which is authorized to report out a bill to the 129th Legislature.
