2. Juvenile history record information confidential. Except as provided in
subsection 3, juvenile Juvenile history record information is confidential and not open to
public inspection, and does not constitute public records as defined in Title 1, section 402,
subsection 3.
Sec. 2. 15 MRSA §3010, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 365, §9 and affected
by §37, is repealed.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

10 SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the provision of law that allows to be disclosed publicly an adjudication and resulting disposition of a juvenile who has been adjudicated to have committed a juvenile crime that would constitute murder or a Class A, B or C crime if the juvenile were an adult.
