1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-KKK** is enacted to read:

3 **§3174-KKK. Reimbursement for costs of circumcision**

4 Beginning January 1, 2024, the department shall provide reimbursement under the
5 MaineCare program for the costs of circumcision for a newly born male infant.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill requires the MaineCare program to provide reimbursement for the costs of
8 newly born male infant circumcision beginning January 1, 2024.
