1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	The bill would establish a tax rebate program for certain electricity ratepayers. It would
6	provide a \$1,000 tax rebate for residential ratepayers. It would also provide a \$2,500 tax
/	rebate for businesses with high energy usage.
