2	Sec. 1. 16 MRSA §807, as amended by PL 2013, c. 507, §8, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4 5 6 7	This bill repeals the provision of law that prohibits a Maine criminal justice agency from confirming the existence or nonexistence of confidential intelligence and investigative record information to any person or public or private entity that is not eligible to receive the information itself.
