3 4	9. Veteran priority. An antlerless deer permit system adopted by the commissioner pursuant to this section must give priority in the issuance of permits to veterans. For
5	purposes of this subsection, "veteran" means a person who was honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires an antlerless deer permit system adopted by the Commissioner of
9	Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to give priority in the issuance of a permit to a veteran who
10	was honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States or the National
11	Guard.
