An Act To Improve Efficiency and Compliance within the Judicial System

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §164, sub-§12, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, c. 549, §3 and affected by §17, is amended to read:

B. The Chief Judge by order, which may from time to time be amended, shall designate the amount of fines imposed for traffic infractions. If payment in full of a fine imposed for a traffic infraction is received by the violations bureau within the 20day period immediately after the Violation Summons and Complaint has been served, the fine must be reduced by 10%.

SUMMARY

This bill provides that if a fine imposed for a traffic infraction is paid in full and received by the judicial branch's violations bureau within the 20day period immediately after the Violation Summons and Complaint has been served, the fine must be reduced by 10%.
