1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §565-C is enacted to read:
3 4	§565-C. Maximum temperatures and minimum temperatures in indoor places of employment
5 6 7	1. Indoor temperatures. An employer shall maintain indoor temperatures at workplaces to ensure safe and healthful conditions of employees according to rules adopted by the board.
8 9 10 11	2. Rules. The board shall adopt rules establishing maximum and minimum temperatures for indoor places of employment pursuant to this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are major substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
12	SUMMARY
13 14 15	This bill requires the Department of Labor, Board of Occupational Safety and Health to establish minimum temperatures and maximum temperatures in indoor places of employment.
