1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §101, sub-§20-A is enacted to read:
3 4	20-A. Delivery vehicle. "Delivery vehicle" means a motor vehicle used to transport customers or property to or from a place of business.
5 6	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§4, ¶¶B and C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to read:
7	B. On a semitrailer, on the front portion of the semitrailer; and
8 9	C. On a truck, on the front portion of the storage compartment above and behind the cab-; and
10	Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§4, ¶D is enacted to read:
11	D. On a delivery vehicle, on the roof of the vehicle.
12	SUMMARY
13	This bill allows a delivery vehicle to display a lighted advertising sign on its roof.
