4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6 7 8 9	Under current law, a naturopathic doctor may prescribe nonprescription medications, homeopathic remedies, vitamins and minerals, hormones, local anesthesia and immunizations that are designated by rule by a subcommittee of the Board of Complementary Health Care Providers. This bill proposes to expand the authority of naturopathic doctors to prescribe certain naturally occurring medications.
