1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4722, sub-§2, ¶¶D and E,</b> as enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. C, §§5 and 7, are amended to read:
4	D. Science, including at least one year of laboratory study2 years; and
5	E. Fine arts, which may include art, music, forensics or dramaone year-; and
6	Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §4722, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:
7	F. Career and education developmentone semester or its equivalent.

9 10	This bill makes career and education development a required one-semester course to receive a high school diploma.
