4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6 7 8	This bill proposes to amend the provisions in law requiring a certain amount of instock spirits for agency liquor stores by allowing agency liquor stores in smaller municipalities or municipalities with seasonal populations to carry less in-stock spirits than currently required.
