Resolve, Directing the Department of Education To Amend Its Rules Pertaining to the Statute of Limitations for Filing a Due Process Hearing Request Regarding Special Education

Sec. 1 Rules amended. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall amend its rules in Chapter 101: Maine Unified Special Education Regulation in Section XVI to clarify that a due process hearing request must allege a violation that occurred not more than 6 years before the date the parent or public agency knew or should have known about the alleged action that forms the basis of the due process hearing request.

SUMMARY

This resolve restores to 6 years the statute of limitations for filing a due process hearing request in special education matters.
