| 4 5 | 1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings. |

"Flavored tobacco product" means any tobacco product that imparts a taste or smell, other than the taste or smell of tobacco, that is distinguishable by an ordinary consumer either prior to or during the consumption of a tobacco product, including, but not limited to, any taste or smell relating to fruit, menthol, mint, wintergreen, chocolate, cocoa, vanilla, honey or any candy, dessert, beverage, herb or spice. |
| 11 | B. "Tobacco product" has the same meaning as in Title 22, section 1551, subsection 3. |
| 12 13 | C. "Tobacco retailer" has the same meaning as in Title 22, section 1551, subsection 3-A. |
| 14 15 16 | 2. Limitation. A municipality may not adopt or enforce an ordinance that prohibits a tobacco retailer licensed in accordance with Title 22, chapter 262-A, subchapter 1 from selling a flavored tobacco product. |

| 18 19 | This bill prohibits a municipality from adopting or enforcing an ordinance prohibiting a tobacco retailer from selling flavored tobacco products. |
