1 Sec. 1. State Auditor to audit all state agencies. Resolved: That the State 2 Auditor shall audit all state agencies and compile a report that lists for each state agency: 3 A. The number of current employees; 4 B. The number of newly hired employees over the last 5, 10, 15 and 20 years; 5 C. The current budget and the projected budget; 6 D. The growth of the budget over the last 5, 10, 15 and 20 years; 7 E. The agency's jurisdiction, roles and responsibilities; 8 F. The scope of current projects and projects completed or incomplete over the past 5, 9 10, 15 and 20 years; and 10 G. The percentage of the total of the most current state budget that the agency's current 11 budget represents. 12 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the State Auditor shall submit the report under section 1 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 13 appropriations and financial affairs no later than December 4, 2024. 14 **SUMMARY** 15 This resolve requires the State Auditor to audit all state agencies and compile a report 16 for each state agency listing the number of current employees, the number of newly hired 17 18 employees over a period of time, the current and projected budget, the growth of the budget 19 over a period of time, the agency's jurisdiction, roles and responsibilities, the scope of 20 current, completed and incomplete projects over a period of time and the percentage of the total of the most current state budget the agency's budget represents. 21
