1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to control the problems caused by browntail moths by:
6 7 8	1. Requiring a state agency, on its own or by contracting with an outside entity, to determine the best practices for controlling or eliminating the browntail moth infestation in Maine; and
9 10	2. Appropriating funds for payment to members of the public for the collection and disposal of browntail moth cocoons.
