	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$12,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
fu	nd to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city
of	Oak Park Heights to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip public infrastructure
fo	r development of the Allen S. King power plant site in the city of Oak Park Heights. Public
in	frastructure includes clean water systems, sanitary sewer systems, stormwater systems,
ro	ads, trails, and sidewalks. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of
m	anagement and budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to
