1.9	INCREASES.
1.10	Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, salary increases shall apply to the following
1.11	employees whose exclusive representative is the Minnesota Law Enforcement Association:
1.12	(1) the commissioner of public safety must increase the salary paid to state patrol troopers,
1.13	Bureau of Criminal Apprehension agents, and special agents in the gambling enforcement
1.14	division by 8.4 percent.:
1.15	(2) the commissioner of natural resources must increase the salary paid to conservation
1.16	officers by 8.4 percent;
1.17	(3) the commissioner of corrections must increase the salary paid to fugitive specialists
1.18	by 8.4 percent; and

2.9	(c) \$587,000 in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the game and fish fund to the
