1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state lands; authorizing conveyance of certain tax-forfeited land that
1.3 borders public water.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND BORDERING PUBLIC
1.6 WATER; GOODHUE COUNTY.

1.7 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45 and 282.018, subdivision 1, and
1.8 the public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282, Goodhue County may convey
1.9 to Goodhue County for no consideration the tax-forfeited land bordering public water that
1.10 is described in paragraph (c).

1.11 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general and provide
1.12 that the land reverts to the state if Goodhue County stops using the land for the public
1.13 purpose described in paragraph (d). The attorney general may make changes to the land
1.14 description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

1.15 (c) The land to be conveyed is located in Goodhue County and is described as: the West
1.16 4 chains and 78 links of the North 33 chains of the Southwest Quarter of Section 7, Township
1.17 109 North, Range 18 West, also described as Lot 11 of Auditor's Subdivision of the
1.18 Southwest Quarter of said Section 7, except all that part of said tract which lies South of
1.19 the south bank of the Zumbro River (parcel number 36.150.0090).

1.20 (d) The county has determined that the land is needed for a county park.
