1.8	encouraged to have an adequate student-to-counselor ratio for its students beginning in the
1.9	2015-2016 school year and later must have a school counselor in every district school
1.10	building that serves students in any grade from kindergarten through grade 12.
1.11	(b) A school counselor shall assist a student in meeting the requirements for high school
1.12	graduation, college and career exploration, and selection, college affordability planning,
