1.6	Subd. 3. <b>Issuance after conviction; big game.</b> (a) A person may not <u>use a big-game</u>
1.7	license purchased before conviction, obtain any a big-game license, or take big game under
1.8	a lifetime license, issued under section 97A.473, for three years after the person is convicted
1.9	of:
1.10	(1) a gross misdemeanor violation under the game and fish laws relating to big game;
1.11	(2) doing an act without a required big-game license; or
1.12	(3) the second violation within three years under the game and fish laws relating to big
1.13	game.
1.14	(b) A person may not obtain any deer license or take deer under a lifetime license issued
1.15	under section 97A.473 for one year after the person is convicted of hunting deer with the
