1.7	(a) In order to maximize delivery of services to the public, if layoffs of state employees
1.8	are necessary, each agency with more than 50 full-time equivalent employees must reduce
1.9	at least the same percentage of management and supervisory personnel as line and support
1.10	personnel.
1.11	(b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if layoffs of state employees are necessary
1.12	due to a shortage of funds, each agency must make personnel reductions so that economies
1.13	of the state outside the metropolitan area, as defined in section 473.121, subdivision 2, are
1.14	not disproportionately affected by the layoffs.
