	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$400,000 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the
Į	general fund to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities. Of
1	this amount, \$250,000 is for transfer to Winona State University and \$150,000 is for transfer
t	o Minnesota State College Southeast for the purposes in subdivision 2. Notwithstanding
l	Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.28, unencumbered balances under this section do not cancel
1	until July 1, 2025.
	Subd. 2. Career and technical educator pilot project. By the 2024-2025 school year,
	Winona State University must develop a teacher preparation program that leads to initial
]	licensure in at least one license area under Minnesota Rules, parts 8710.8000 to 8710.8080.
1	Winona State University must partner with Minnesota State College Southeast to provide
1	the subject matter training necessary for license areas chosen. If practical, the partnership
1	must result in a candidate earning an associate's degree from Minnesota State College
5	Southeast and a bachelor's degree from Winona State University. The appropriation under
