1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to natural resources; modifying definition of all-terrain vehicle; amending
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 84.92, subdivision 8.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 84.92, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 8. All-terrain vehicle or vehicle. (a) "All-terrain vehicle" or "vehicle" means a
1.7 motorized vehicle with: (1) not less than three, but not more than six low pressure or
1.8 non-pneumatic tires; (2) a total dry weight of 2,000 3,000 pounds or less; and (3) a total
1.9 width from outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim that is 65 inches or less. All-terrain
1.10 vehicle includes a class 1 all-terrain vehicle and class 2 all-terrain vehicle.

1.11 (b) All-terrain vehicle does not include an electric-assisted bicycle as defined in section
1.12 169.011, subdivision 27, golf cart, mini-truck, dune buggy, or go-cart or a vehicle designed
1.13 and used specifically for lawn maintenance, agriculture, logging, or mining purposes.
