- 1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 148.512, subdivision 17a, is amended to read:
- 1.8 Subd. 17a. **Speech-language pathology assistant.** "Speech-language pathology assistant"
- 1.9 means a person who meets the qualifications under section 148.5181 and provides
- 1.10 speech-language pathology services under the supervision of a licensed speech-language
- 1.11 pathologist under sections 122A.183 and 122A.184 or in accordance with section 148.5192.
- 1.12 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 148.5192, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
- 1.13 Subd. 3. **Supervision requirements.** (a) A supervising speech-language pathologist
- 1.14 shall authorize and accept full responsibility for the performance, practice, and activity of
- 1.15 a speech-language pathology assistant. The amount and type of supervision required must
- 1.16 be based on the skills and experience of the speech-language pathology assistant. A minimum
- 1.17 of one hour every 30 days of consultative supervision time must be documented for each
- 1.18 speech-language pathology assistant.
- 1.19 (b) A supervising speech-language pathologist must:
- 1.20 (1) be licensed under sections 122A.183, 122A.184, or 148.511 to 148.5198;
- 1.21 (2) hold a certificate of clinical competence from the American Speech-Language-Hearing
- 1.22 Association or its equivalent as approved by the commissioner; and

2.1 (3) have completed at least ten hours of continuing education in supervision.

2.2 (c) Once every 60 days, the supervising speech-language pathologist must treat or cotreat
2.3 with the speech-language pathology assistant each client on the speech-language pathology
2.4 assistant's caseload.

2.5 (d) For purposes of this section, "direct supervision" means observation and guidance
2.6 by the supervising speech-language pathologist during the performance of a delegated duty
2.7 that occurs either on-site and in-view or through the use of real-time, two-way interactive
2.8 audio and visual communication. The supervision requirements described in this section
2.9 are minimum requirements. Additional supervision requirements may be imposed at the
2.10 discretion of the supervising speech-language pathologist.

2.11 (e) A supervising speech-language pathologist must be available to communicate with
2.12 a speech-language pathology assistant at any time the assistant is in direct contact with a
2.13 client.

2.14 (f) A supervising speech-language pathologist must document activities performed by
2.15 the assistant that are directly supervised by the supervising speech-language pathologist.
2.16 At a minimum, the documentation must include:

2.17 (1) information regarding the quality of the speech-language pathology assistant's
2.18 performance of the delegated duties; and

2.19 (2) verification that any delegated clinical activity was limited to duties authorized to
2.20 be performed by the speech-language pathology assistant under this section.

2.21 (g) A supervising speech-language pathologist must review and cosign all informal
2.22 treatment notes signed or initialed by the speech-language pathology assistant.

2.23 (h) A full-time, speech-language pathologist may supervise no more than two full-time,
2.24 speech-language pathology assistants or the equivalent of two full-time assistants.
