The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for water infrastructure in the
1.3 city of Carlton and Twin Lakes Township; authorizing the sale and issuance of
1.4 state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. WATER INFRASTRUCTURE EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENTS;
1.7 CITY OF CARLTON AND TWIN LAKES TOWNSHIP.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$8,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to Twin Lakes Township for the design and
1.10 construction of a water distribution system, support facilities, and related water
1.11 improvements, including a water main extension from the city of Carlton, along marked
1.12 Trunk Highway 210 in Carlton County.

1.13 Subd. 2. Appropriation. \$3,800,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to
1.14 the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Carlton for construction of
1.15 improvements to its water treatment, well, and water supply facilities.

1.16 Subd. 3. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.17 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.18 the state in an amount up to \$11,800,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.19 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.20 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.21 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
