1.7	Subdivision 1. Establishment. The excellence in teaching program is established to
1.8	promote the National Board Certification of Teachers throughout the state of Minnesota.
1.9	Subd. 2. Coordinator. The executive director of the Board of Teaching shall
1.10	appoint a statewide coordinator for the program under this section. The coordinator's
1.11	duties shall include, but are not limited to:
1.12	(1) promoting understanding of the National Board Certification process throughout
1.13	the state;
1.14	(2) coordinating technical support for National Board Certification candidates;
1.15	(3) maintaining an online platform for candidate recruitment and support;
1.16	(4) collaborating with education stakeholder groups and organizations; and
1.17	(5) partnering with the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards as
1.18	necessary to implement the purposes of the program.
1.19	Subd. 3. Incentive grants. The Board of Teaching shall award a onetime incentive
1.20	grant of \$2,000 to any Minnesota teacher who achieves National Board Certification
