The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Public Safety Policy and Oversight

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to public safety; impaired driving; providing for probation violation
1.3 for any impaired driving offender driving with any presence of alcohol during
1.4 the period of probation; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.5 chapter 169A.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **[169A.79] PROBATION VIOLATION; ZERO TOLERANCE.**

1.8 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or any other section of
1.9 Minnesota Statutes, a person who has been sentenced to probation following conviction
1.10 for a violation of section 169A.20 or 609.21 is prohibited as a condition of probation from
1.11 driving when there is any amount of alcohol present in the person's body.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2009, and is effective for
1.13 driving incidents occurring on or after that date.
