1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.02, subdivision 16, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 16. Qualified domestic violence-related offense. "Qualified domestic
1.8 violence-related offense" includes a violation of or an attempt to violate sections 518B.01,
1.9 subdivision 14 (violation of domestic abuse order for protection); 609.185 (first-degree
1.10 murder); 609.19 (second-degree murder); 609.195 (third-degree murder); 609.20, clauses
1.11 (1), (2), and (5) (first-degree manslaughter); 609.205, clauses (1) and (5) (second-degree
1.12 manslaughter); 609.221 (first-degree assault); 609.222 (second-degree assault); 609.223
1.13 (third-degree assault); 609.2231 (fourth-degree assault); 609.224 (fifth-degree assault);
1.14 609.2242 (domestic assault); 609.2245 (female genital mutilation); 609.2247 (domestic
1.15 assault by strangulation); 609.25 (kidnapping); 609.255 (false imprisonment); 609.342
1.16 (first-degree criminal sexual conduct); 609.343 (second-degree criminal sexual conduct);
