1.8	(a) The balance remaining in the renewable development account established under
1.9	Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision 1, as of the effective date of this act is
1.10	transferred to the commissioner of commerce to provide additional heating assistance through
1.11	the low-income home energy assistance program under United States Code, title 42, sections
1.12	8621 to 8630, and Minnesota Statutes, section 216C.02, subdivision 1. No more than five
1.13	percent of this appropriation may be used for expenses to administer the program. Any
1.14	unspent balance available on June 30, 2021, cancels to the renewable development account.
1.15	(b) The funding provided in this section supplements but does not replace any federal
