(b) The commissioner may petition county boards to change the name of lakes, rivers, streams, or other bodies of water where the name has existed for 40 years or more and may change the name after receiving resolutions approving the name change from all local units of government with jurisdiction over the lake, river, stream, or other body of water and with jurisdiction over the land surrounding the lake, river, stream, or other body of water.

(c) For the purposes of this subdivision, "local units of government" means counties, cities, organized townships, tribal governments, and special purpose governmental units.
