1.8	(b) For the purpose of this section "public assistance recipient" means an individual
1.9	enrolled in MFIP under chapter 256J or the basic sliding fee assistance program under
1.10	section 119B.03.
1.11	(c) Applicants who meet the minimum qualifications for a vacant position and claim
1.12	public assistance recipient preference shall be listed in the applicant pool ahead of all other
1.13	applicants, except veterans under section 43A.11.
