- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 97C.315, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.6Subdivision 1. **Lines.** An angler may not use more than one line, except that:
- 1.7(1) two lines may be used to take fish through the ice;
- 1.8(2) the commissioner may, by rule, authorize the use of two lines in areas designated by
- 1.9the commissioner in Lake Superior; ~~and~~
- 1.10(3) two lines may be used in the Minnesota River downstream of the Granite Falls Dam
- 1.11~~and in the Mississippi River downstream of St. Anthony Falls; and~~
- 1.12(4) three lines may be used in the Mississippi River and the St. Croix River.
