.6	or other law to the contrary, St. Louis County may sell by private sale the tax-forfeited
.7	land described in paragraph (c).
.8	(b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
.9	general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.
.10	(c) The land to be sold is located in St. Louis County and is described as: that
.11	part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter beginning on the east line at the
.12	southerly road right-of-way; thence southerly along the east line 760.07 feet; thence South
