1.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 171.20, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
1.8	Subd. 4. Reinstatement fee. (a) Before the license is reinstated, (1) an individual whose
1.9	driver's license has been suspended under section 171.16, subdivisions 2 and 3; 171.175;
1.10	171.18; or 171.182, or who has been disqualified from holding a commercial driver's license
1.11	under section 171.165, and (2) an individual whose driver's license has been suspended
1.12	under section 171.186 and who is not exempt from such a fee, must pay a fee of \$20.
1.13	(b) Before the license is reinstated, an individual whose license has been suspended
1.14	under sections 169.791 to 169.798 must pay a \$20 reinstatement fee.
1.15	(c) When fees are collected by a licensing agent appointed under section 171.061, a
1.16	handling charge is imposed in the amount specified under section 171.061, subdivision 4.
1.17	The reinstatement fee and surcharge must be deposited in an approved state depository as
1.18	directed under section 171.061, subdivision 4.
1.19	(d) Reinstatement fees collected under paragraph (a) for suspensions under sections
1.20	171.16, subdivision 3, and 171.18, subdivision 1, clause (10), must be deposited in the
1.21	special revenue fund and are appropriated to the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board
1.22	for peace officer training reimbursement to local units of government.
1.23	(e) (d) A suspension may be rescinded without fee for good cause.

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Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 171.26, subdivision 1, is amended to read: 2.1 Subdivision 1. Driver services operating account. All money received under this 2.2 chapter must be paid into the state treasury and credited to the driver services operating 2.3 account in the special revenue fund specified under sections 299A.705, except as provided 2.4 in subdivision 2; 171.06, subdivision 2a; 171.07, subdivision 11, paragraph (g); 171.20, 2.5 subdivision 4, paragraph (d); and 171.29, subdivision 2, paragraph (b). 2.6 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 357.021, subdivision 7, is amended to read: 2.7 Subd. 7. Disbursement of surcharges by commissioner of management and 2.8 **budget.** (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b), (c), and to (d), the commissioner of 2.9 management and budget shall disburse surcharges received under subdivision 6 and section 2.10 97A.065, subdivision 2, as follows: 2.11 (1) one percent shall be credited to the peace officer training account in the game and 2.12 fish fund to provide peace officer training for employees of the Department of Natural 2.13 Resources who are licensed under sections 626.84 to 626.863, and who possess peace officer 2.14 authority for the purpose of enforcing game and fish laws; and 2.15 (2) 39 percent shall be credited to the peace officers training account in the special 2.16 revenue fund; and 2.17 (3) 60 (2) 99 percent shall be credited to the general fund. 2.18 (b) The commissioner of management and budget shall credit \$3 of each surcharge 2.19 received under subdivision 6 and section 97A.065, subdivision 2, to the general fund. 2.20 (c) In addition to any amounts credited under paragraph (a), the commissioner of 2.21 management and budget shall credit \$47 of each surcharge received under subdivision 6 2.22 and section 97A.065, subdivision 2, and the \$12 parking surcharge, to the general fund. 2.23 (d) If the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners authorizes imposition of the additional 2.24 \$1 surcharge provided for in subdivision 6, paragraph (a), the court administrator in the 2.25 Second Judicial District shall transmit the surcharge to the commissioner of management 2.26 and budget.
