1.9	to those injuries, the trustee appointed in subdivision 3 may maintain an action for special
1.10	damages arising out of such injury if the decedent might have maintained an action therefore
1.11	had the decedent lived.
1.12	(b) If the injury under paragraph (a) is caused to a person who was a vulnerable adult,
