1.6	(a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, chapter 6106, the following area in the city of St.
1.7	Paul Park that is currently designated as a rural and open space district (CA-ROS) is
1.8	redesignated as a river neighborhood district (CA-RN): those parts of Sections 12, 13, and
1.9	24, Township 27 North, Range 22 West, lying West of 3rd Street and County Road 75.
1.10	(b) The commissioner of natural resources must amend the map maintained under
1.11	Minnesota Rules, part 6106.0100, subpart 9, to reflect the redesignation under paragraph
