1.9	cooperation with the Department of Natural Resources and other conservation partners, to
1.10	provide hunters with outreach and workshops on alternatives to lead ammunition for hunting,
1.11	including copper ammunition as an alternative, and to promote voluntary selection of
1.12	nontoxic ammunition to protect raptors and other wildlife in Minnesota from accidental
1.13	lead poisoning caused by ingesting ammunition fragments. This is a onetime appropriation
