1.8	REVOCATION.
1.9	When a person is convicted of violating a provision of sections 152.021 to 152.027 and
1.10	152.0262 152.021; 152.022; 152.023; 152.024, except a small amount of marijuana for no
1.11	remuneration under subdivision 1, clause (4); 152.025, except a small amount of marijuana
1.12	for no remuneration under subdivision 1, clause (1), and except a small amount of marijuana
1.13	under subdivision 2, clause (1); 152.026; 152.0262; and 152.027, except subdivision 4, the
1.14	sentencing court shall determine whether the person unlawfully sold or possessed the
1.15	controlled substance while driving a motor vehicle. If so, the court shall notify the
