1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 13.643, subdivision 7, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 7. Research, monitoring, or assessment data. (a) Except as provided in paragraph
1.8	(b), the following data created, collected, and or maintained by the Department of Agriculture
1.9	or the University of Minnesota during research, monitoring, or the assessment of farm
1.10	practices and related to natural resources, the environment, agricultural facilities, or
1.11	agricultural practices are classified as private or nonpublic:
1.12	(1) names, addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses of study participants or
1.13	cooperators; and
1.14	(2) location of research, study site, and global positioning system data; and
1.15	(3) data created, collected, or maintained by the University of Minnesota for inclusion
